Congratulations! The Durbanville Lions Club's sponsored entry created by Lezé Calitz has been chosen as a **merit award winner in the 36**th **Annual Lions International Peace Poster Contest.**

Approximately 600,000 children from 60 countries participated in this year's Peace Poster Contest. The posters were judged at the club, district and multiple district levels before reaching the international level, at which point they had been narrowed down to 115 posters. Based on creativity, originality and portrayal of the theme," **Dare to Dream** the club's entry was chosen as one of 23 merit award winners. As such, Lezé will receive US\$500 and a certificate of merit.

The 23 merit award winners are from Colombia, China, Estonia, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, MD 300 Taiwan, New Zealand, Peru, South Africa, Sri Lanka, Trinidad and Tobago, United States (Florida, Georgia, New Hampshire, and Wyoming). The grand prize winner will be announced at the Lions Day with the United Nations on March 1, 2024. Information about the grand prize winner will be posted on the on Peace Poster Section of the LCI website and LCI's social media shortly thereafter.
